Submission of Papers

The abstract, which should be between 300-500 words, must outline the aim and objectives of the paper, the methodology, applications, and the main findings. The abstract must include the following information: 1) publication title, 2) name, mailing address, and e-mail of author(s). All abstracts will be evaluated based on anonymous peer review.

All those interested in publishing their presentations in the Conference Proceedings must submit completed research papers in Greek or English by June 30, 2020, via the National Documentation Centre. All papers will be evaluated using the double-blind peer review process.
